## SPACIOUS LIVING


As the living room and the dining area share the same space, the designers applied the same shades of colour and woodgrains in order for the open-concept space to have a unified, cosy atmosphere. While the sofa is situated to subtly separate the living room from the dining zone, a gold pendant lamp helps to anchor the dining area.



## STYLISH STORAGE

To make good use of the wall space, the designers constructed floor-to-ceiling cabinets and display shelves, giving the homeowners and their children a good mix of closed and open storage solutions. These full-height storage units frame the TV and the accompanying TV console, creating not just storage space but also a neat feature wall that serves as a focal point in the living room.





**A STRIKING WALL**

Tucked at the end of the room is the cosy dining area swathed in earthy browns and glamorous gold hues. Mosaic tiles in a combination of dark brown and shiny gold cover the wall all the way to the top, creating a beautiful feature wall that is certain to draw the attention of all who enter the house. A booth seat with a cushioned backrest provides ample seating while hidden storage space beneath allows the homeowners to keep their household items out of sight.

**CLEAN AND MODERN**

Since certain areas of the apartment have already been done up by the private developer, the design team decided to adopt the style. A dark woodgrain laminate was chosen to match the other woodgrain finishes and the white countertop. A soothing palette of brown and taupe ties the different spaces together, creating a cohesive look for this modern home.

**SHARED SPACE**

To create an expansive space for the children to rest, play and study, the designers hacked down the walls and combined two bedrooms to become one large room. A spacious workstation stands in the middle of the room, complete with overhead cabinets and task lighting to provide the kids with a space conducive for work and study.
